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KISSED BY THE SEA

Genesin Casa Amica signs this modern and fascinating interior design, in line with the landscape of the Croatian island where the house is located.

The charm of an island and the pleasure of the sea, which laps onto its sides by creating an incessant and melodic background that accompanies the unfolding of days... A highly-appealing daily perspective that tickles our souls. It happens here, in this strip of unspoiled and wild floating land in Croatia, where this house with linear and contemporary features is perfectly nestled in the landscape context, made of hills and the sea that seem to seep in through the large panoramic windows. All this beauty and comfort will benefit a young couple and their tender little dog, always there, mastering the spaces with a decisive and nice attitude.

We can also define this house as a holiday retreat, a place to be experienced for its hospitality and relaxation, perfectly designed to be habitable even for long periods, given the fact that the homeowners can live it thanks to remote working.

Here, the blend between the calm and unspoiled landscape and the owners' soul – sun and colour lovers, who are looking for tranquillity – is very strong, thus allowing them to fully enjoy everyday life with its comforts.

In the living area, there is a large relaxation space focused on the sofa, with soft and sinuous seats, with several modular positions to adapt to different needs. A wall is embellished by a niche covered with modern wallpaper that forms the backdrop for a modern vertical element in délabré brass, while the armchair completes the living space, leaving the view on the outside unhindered.

In the background, water and hills create a natural setting for the large terrace, dominated by strong chromatic contrasts that exude refinement and charm, both for the materials and the workmanship. The elegant weaves with contemporary hand-made materials of the Ami armchair stand out, as well as the Wave chaises longues, the Otto pouffes and the large Sciarra table, with a lava stone top on a glass surface, whose result is always unique and one-of-a-kind.

In the most intimate area, the bedrooms show off light and performing elements: floating beds and bedside tables, wardrobe containers with chromatic or neutral effects... a clear invitation to a relaxing and peaceful sleep.

The bathroom, on the other hand, is dedicated to awakening, to the energy of the day, and the preparation for various daily activities. A support surface in natural wood houses the two washbasins, underneath there is a container with a glossy gold finish that matches the main wall cladding, which elegantly defines the environment. The result is a furnishing project that totally fulfils the concept of life that the young owners share in these domestic spaces, so intensely nestled into the hilly and marine landscape that you can constantly enjoy its scent and its sound.
