TO NEW HEIGHTS WITH ROPE AND ASH WOOD

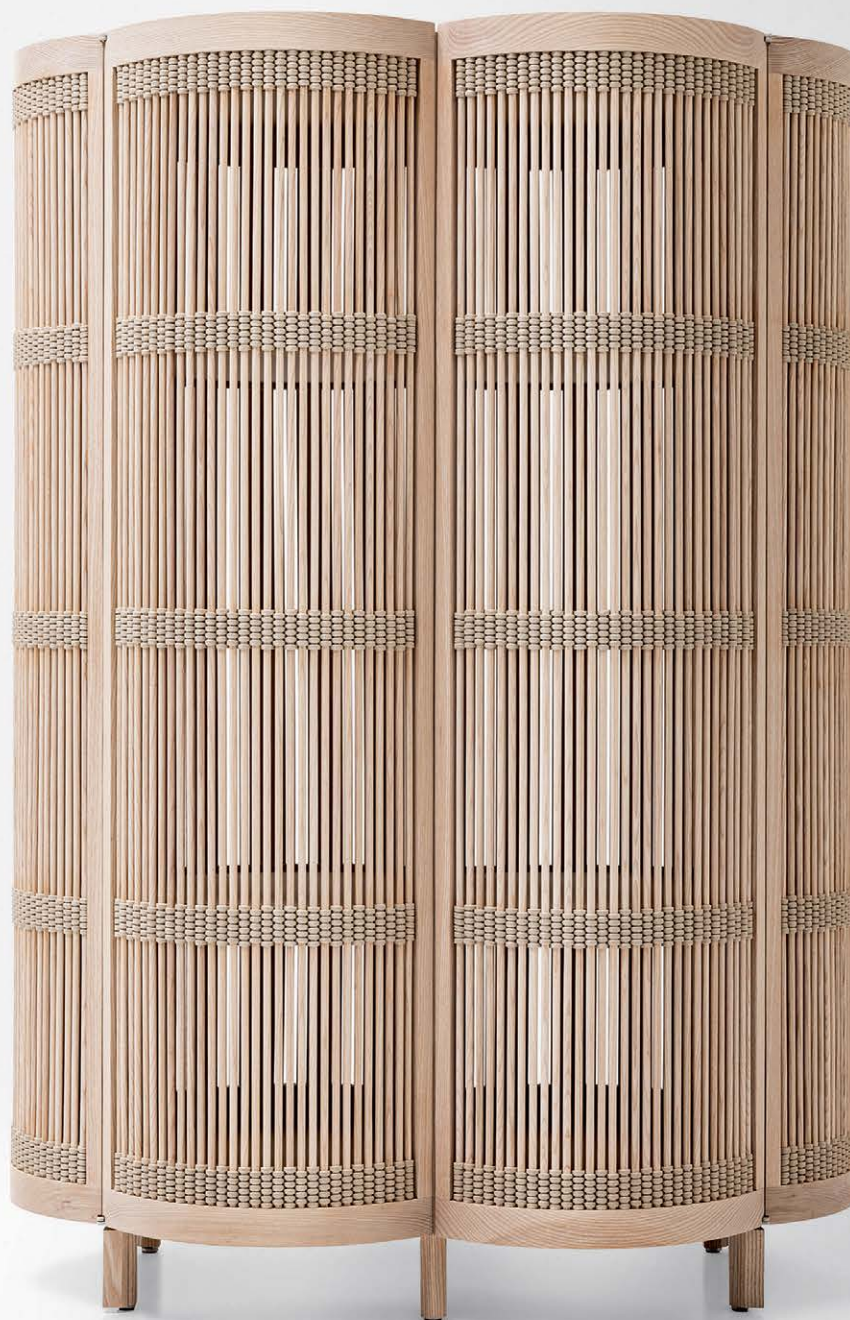

THE PIECE

Paola Lenti's latest limited-edition masterpiece, the Nuvola is a cabinet defined by its curvature and the interplay of light and wood. Handmade with meticulous details, the piece shapes and transforms its surroundings with its organic presence.

THE MATERIALS

The Nuvola's structure is made of natural ash and heartwood, with fixed shelves in blockboard veneered with ash wood. The cabinet's hinges are made of varnished steel, and its doors are hand-woven with rope yarn.



THE DESIGNER

One of design's foremost visionaries, Michele De Lucchi is the head and founder of AMDL Circle in Milan and has designed furnishings for some of the best-known European brands today. His philosophy?
