Whether crafting a cozy corner or outfitting a sprawling salon, Victor Camasco urges you to take **Cover**. The Valencia, Spain-based designer's multi-piston modular seating system encourages imaginative specification. Anchoring the series are left-, right-, and center-facing sofas that can be combined in any number of ways. Like to stretch out? Consider adding the chaise longue. Prefer to perch? Choose the square pouf. Bentwood frames are padded with stress-resistant expanded polyurethane and can be upholstered in a variety of fabrics. A gas-piston mechanism raises and lowers backrests; a steel coupling system links the upholstered pieces. Optional square tables, also in bentwood, can provide surface space throughout. When autumn leaves start to fall, seek stylish shelter within.

**Pavilion.** Designed by M-AR by Renato J. Morganti, this modular shading structure features a hexagonal roof with an extruded-aluminum frame, supported by three or five stainless-steel-framed side panels with co-molded polyurethane and steel joints. The silicone gaskets are UV resistant and waterproof, ensuring protection from the elements. Available in two sizes, Pavilion can be fixed to hard flooring surfaces or installed on softer ground by way of a ballasted base. Side panels are made of white polyester or Paola Lenti's signature Thulac; covers attach to the structure with Velcro strips for easy assembly and disassembly.
