Start at the North Dome and check out the expansive **Interior Supply**, with a showroom boasting big names in European design such as Poltrona Frau, Fendi Casa and Kenzo Maison. Next, head to **Altfield**'s sumptuous textile showroom, with its rails of covetable fabric samples, wall coverings and leather.

Walk through to **Evitavonni** for inspirational room sets filled with elegant furniture, lighting, and bath and bed linen ranges. Visit the awe-inspiring **Chaplins** for slick international brands Vitra, Ligne Roset, Knoll, Flos and Cassina. **Top Floor Rugs** showcases distinctive contemporary handmade rugs and carpets, with the recent addition of soft furnishings and all-timber engineered wood flooring. **Whistler Leather** is a candy shop of exquisite leather samples with innovative textures and finishes.

Down one floor, you'll find modern classics

at Italian furniture showroom **Porada**. Head across to **Ann Sacks**, which offers a collection of swish tiles, exquisite stone and luxury plumbing products.

Next door, Spanish fabric house **Lizzo** is known for its opulent modern fabrics. Visit **Colefax and Fowler** – an iconic name in English fabrics, wallpapers and trimmings – to check out its new collection of floral and animal-inspired woven fabrics.

The sleek **Interdesign** showroom offers a compendium of Italian contemporary homeware brands, including Flexform, Gallotti&Radice, Paola Lenti, La Palma and Penta. Italian brand **Poliform** showcases a snapshot from all its ranges, including wardrobes, beds, library systems and sleek Varenna kitchens.

Just outside the South Dome is **Vaughan**, a specialist in decorative lighting. One floor up, visit **Lewis & Wood** for a charming range of English fabrics and wide-width wallpapers. Finally, pop into **Dedar** for a seductive range of trimmings in unexpected patterns.
